Reservation is mandatory because there are entrances all the time. Is it possible to book Borghese Gallery for the first Sunday of the month? On the first Sunday of the month, entry is free until you can accommodate as many people as possible in the museum. What days is the museum closed? Borghese Gallery is closed every Monday with exceptions. Can I book voice guides at Borghese Gallery? Voice controllers cannot be allocated. they must be rented directly from the museum. The languages are Italian, English, French, Spanish and German. How many advances do I have to respect to get tickets to the box office? Tickets must be picked up at the ticket office no later than half an hour before the start of the booked entrance time. Late people lose the right of entry and no refund is granted. How many people get to the museum per entrance? A maximum of 360 people can be carried to the museum at the same time. How much time do I need to see the Borth Gallery? The ticket is valid for two hours, leaving the museum is mandatory at the end of the visiting shift. Can I take photos or videos inside the museum? It is forbidden to take photos or videos with lightning. Is it possible to eat and/or drink in a museum? It is forbidden to bring food or drinks to exhibition halls. What is borghese gallery access? Access is at the main entrance. Tickets borghese gallery Does the ticket also include Villa Borghise Gardens? No, because access to the garden is free and open to everyone. Should children under 4 book a ticket to Borghese Gallery? Children, who is between 0 and 4 years old, must not be added to the booking form, comes free of charge and does not have to pay for the ticket. Is anyone over 65 entitled to a discount or free entry to Galleria Borgwe? No, they have to book the whole price ticket. Are teachers entitled to deductions for a visit to Borghese Gallery? Yes, under the following conditions: they must have an open contract and go to the ticket office with an MIUR certificate (which you can find and fill out on the MIUR website).
